www.akc.org/events/scent-work/ for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es).

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs six (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners (mixed breed) listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners (mixed breed) listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Dogs that are both deaf and blind are able to participate so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the class, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge.

ENTRY FEES PER DAY

(includes a \$3.50 AKC recording fee)

Second entry of same dog & Junior Entry..... \$10.00

(includes a \$3.50 AKC recording fee)

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

ICCKC will exercise the right to guarantee Entries for Show Workers:

Per AKC Regulations- The club may guarantee entry spots for show workers who have agreed to work at the trial. Entry spots for show workers are part of the total entry limit stated in the premium list.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Ribbons will be awarded in all Scent Work classes as follows:

First Place.....Blue
Second Place.....Red
Third Place.....Yellow
Fourth Place.....White
A Dark Green Ribbon will be offered for qualifying scores.

A New Title Rosette (offered by ICCKC) will be awarded for completed titles.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all exercises safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Idaho Capital Kennel Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Idaho Capital Kennel Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Idaho Capital Kennel Club or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when competing in the event limits

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Females in season are not permitted to compete in scent work. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season, the club will refund entry fees for bitches unable to compete. The Trial Secretary must be notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial. The club will retain a processing fee of \$5.00 per trial.

REWARDS AND REINFORCERS

When a dog correctly finds the scent, the handler may reward the dog with a food or toy reinforcer. Handlers may reward at or away from source, but must take care not to contaminate the search area with food particles or saliva. If a toy is used, the toy must stay in contact with the handler at all times (toys cannot be thrown). Toys that make noise are not allowed. These items are to be used as a reward only and may not be used to bait the dog.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

It is **not appropriate to visit the trial location** prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

From US 20/US 26/West Chinden Blvd turn North on Glenwood St. Go .1 mile and turn right on Backstretch Rd (just before Baseball stadium). Continue east to open gate.

HOTEL INFORMATION
