Lori and Solei have earned medals in individual and/or team events at all 6 of their international competitions (World Agility Open (2012-2015), FCI Agility World Championship (2015) and IFCS World Agility Championship (2014)).

Although she and her dogs have enjoyed success in both national and international competition, Lori has a passion for teaching her students the necessary connection and teamwork to reach their own goals with their dogs. Lori is an outstanding instructor, both in person and online. Her eye for detail, her personable style and feedback are exceptional. Lori has owned and trained multiple mix-breed rescues, golden retrievers, Shetland sheepdogs and border collies. Her household is currently run by 3 border collies, Solei, C-Ya and Mooz.

Seminar Descriptions:

Private Lessons: An hour to work one-on-one with Lori to address your specific training and handling issues. Extremely limited spots. Can share. *Contact Ariel Agenbroad for more information and schedule. \$105 per hour.*

Total Teamwork: When we train for agility, too often there are details that many of us gloss over because we don't directly see their impact on our performance, but they are what keeps good teams from becoming great teams. This session is for you if you are having issues with keeping your dog focused and engaged with you, losing start line or contact criteria, needing to build or maintain motivation while weaning away from carrying rewards with you, wanting to improve impulse control in more highly stimulating environments, need to develop of adapt pre and post run routines, or simply want to achieve total teamwork with your dog. *Appropriate for all training/competing levels. 12 working spots (\$140 per dog/handler team), 10 auditors (\$70).*

Commit to the Line: In this session, you'll learn how to utilize one of the most magical things about our sport: the dog's path, and how to anticipate and manipulate it so you can get through courses cleanly and effectively. In addition, Lori will share the secret to staying ahead of your dog on course: it is NOT being a world class sprinter, but rather, it's having the ability to delegate responsibility to your teammate to allow you more handling freedom! Better jump commitment can get you through scenarios where your motion traditionally overrides your dog's ability to stay on task.
